

**TOWN OF IRMO
COUNCIL WORKSHOP
February 2, 2021**

The Irmo Town Council held a workshop on Tuesday, February 2, 2021 in the Municipal Building located at 7300 Woodrow Street, Irmo, SC 29063. Council members present were Mayor Walker, Councilwoman Condom, Councilmen Busch, Danielson and Sickinger. Others present were Mr. Robert Brown, Town Administrator, Police Chief Courtney Dennis, Mrs. Vi Racine, Municipal Clerk and Jake Moore, Town Attorney.

The agenda was published and posted on Friday, January 29, 2021 to meet FOIA requirements.

Mayor Walker called the workshop to order at 7:00 P.M.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

A. Blue Granite Sewer / Columbia Water (Mayor)

City of Columbia Sewer representatives Joey Jaco and Clint Shealy were present to discuss how Columbia interacts with Blue Granite Sewer. Mr. Shealy stated that sewer is a tough business to make money due to the constant high maintenance costs. Mr. Shealy stated the project to handle additional customers in Irmo should be completed in 2023. Mayor Walker commented that the Town should move forward with caution.

B. Irmo Police / Inspections of Guest Registers (Staff)

Chief Courtney Dennis explained that having access to the hotel guest registers would aid in tracking suspects.

C. Skatepark (Mayor)

Mayor Walker agreed to reach out to Mr. Rob Cartin and Mr. John Ridenhour to submit more detailed information about the proposed skatepark.


D. Adopting Impact Fees (Busch)
