POLICY LETTER (Park Usage)

The Town of Irmo has two active parks with rental programs. They are the Irmo Town Park located at 7331 Carlisle Street and the Community Park of Irmo located at 7507 Eastview Drive. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis by completing a rental agreement, obtained at the Town Hall and can be completed on the Irmo Website <http://townofirmosc.com> however the reservation is not confirmed until the rental fee and security deposit has been submitted.

The Town Administrator has the authority to waive any and all fees for park usage to allow for special events that benefit the Town and/or its residents. These events can be traditional, educational and promoting the arts. Exceptions may only be granted for non-profit organizations, eleemosynary groups and events being promoted without profit considerations.

No exceptions will be granted for political events, nor for profiting events.
