

NEW BUSINESS

A. FIRST AND FINAL READING OF EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 20-08 AUTHORIZING VIRTUAL AND/OR TELEPHONIC MEETINGS OF COUNCIL, QUORUMS AND VOTING BY VIRTUAL AND/OR TELEPHONIC MEANS, AND OTHER RELATED MEASURES FOR COUNCIL MEETINGS. (MAYOR):

Mayor Walker stated this ordinance would allow Council to hold Virtual and/or Telephonic meeting due social distancing guidelines because of the Covid-19 Virus Pandemic. He explained that the ordinance would automatically end after 60 days. Mr. Sickinger made a motion to approve and Mr. Busch seconded it. The vote for approval was unanimous.
