

**TOWN OF IRMO  
COUNCIL WORKSHOP  
April 6, 2021**

The Irmo Town Council held a workshop on Tuesday, April 6, 2021 in the Municipal Building located at 7300 Woodrow Street, Irmo, SC 29063. Council members present were Mayor Walker, Councilmen Busch, Danielson and Sickinger. Councilwoman Condom was absent. Others present were Mr. Robert Brown, Town Administrator, Police Chief Courtney Dennis, Mrs. Vi Racine, Municipal Clerk and Jake Moore, Town Attorney.

The agenda was published and posted on Friday, April 2, 2021 to meet FOIA requirements.

Mayor Walker called the workshop to order at 7:02 p.m.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

**A. Update on Blue Granite Projects (Don Denton) (Busch)**

Mayor Walker opened the discussion, and Mr. Don Denton, Senior Vice President Operations - East Region at CORIX Group of Companies, gave a presentation along with an update of repairs being made on the Blue Granite sewer system within the Town and answered questions.


**B. American Rescue Plan (Mayor)**

Mayor Walker stated that the first distribution of money should be received by June of 2021 along with Federal guidelines. Council agreed to work up a plan of projects utilizing the money over the next three years. Mr. Danielson suggested a grant for the non-profit Irmo Future Growth Corporation to help small businesses that has been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

**C. Open Floor Discussions**

Mayor Walker stated the Irmo Youth Zone has extended their afterschool activities to the youth residents of Irmo Village Apartments and transportation will be provided.
