

TOWN OF IRMO REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

MAY 3, 2016

The Irmo Town Council held a regular meeting on Tuesday, May 3, 2016 in the Municipal Building. Council members present were Mayor King, Councilmen Pouliot, Waites, Walker and Councilwoman Condom. Others present were Mr. Robert Brown, Town Administrator; Chief Joe Nates; Mr. Eric Hale, Town Attorney; and Mrs. Kim Stanley, Clerk/Treasurer. Mr. Kirk Luther, *The New Irmo News* was also present.

Mayor King called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave the invocation.

READING OF THE MINUTES: Mr. Pouliot made a motion to approve the April 19th, 2016 minutes as submitted. Mrs. Condom seconded the motion. The vote to approve the minutes as submitted was unanimous.

REPORT OF STANDING:

A. Administrative Briefing – The Administrator furnished a written briefing to Council in their agenda packets. [A copy of this briefing is attached]

Mr. Brown stated that the MASC Annual Meeting was scheduled for July 14 -17th and that Council had to complete the registration forms and returned to Town Hall by May 19th.

Mr. Brown mentioned that the City of Columbia wanted to sell the small piece of land located behind Irmo Lock & Key and that the City of Columbia is currently getting the property appraised. He asked Council to let him know if the Town was interested in purchasing the property.

Mrs. Condom seconded the motion. The Mayor stated the budget total for FY 16/17 is \$5,225,371 and \$0 mills. The vote for first reading was unanimous.
