

TOWN OF IRMO SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

July 25, 2019

The Irmo Town Council held a special meeting on Thursday, July 25, 2019 in the Municipal Building. Council members present were Mayor King, Councilmen Pouliot, Waites, Walker and Councilwoman Condom. Others present were Mr. Robert Brown, Town Administrator; Chief Don Perry; Mr. Chip Burns, Town Attorney and Mrs. Renee Caviness, Clerk/Treasurer.

Mayor King called the special meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

AMENDMENTS TO THE AGENDA:

Mr. Walker made a motion to add a statement from Council regarding grass policy and Mrs. Condom seconded it. Mrs. Condom explained that her lawyer is writing a statement for the next meeting. The vote failed 2 to 3 with Mr. Waites, Mayor King and Mr. Pouliot voting in opposition.

NEW BUSINESS

A. SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE 19-12 TO AMEND THE IRMO TOWN CODE, CHAPTER 22 OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS: ARTICLE IV, OFFENSES AGAINST THE PUBLIC PEACE; SECTION 22-105 – USE OF FIREWORKS (STAFF):

Mr. Pouliot made a motion to approve and Mr. Waites seconded it. Mayor King stated that this is an administrative item to correct referenced statutes. The vote for approval was unanimous.

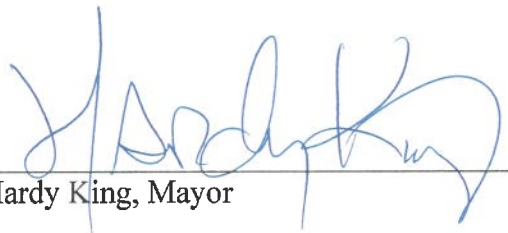
B. FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE 19-13 TO REZONE LEXINGTON COUNTY TMS# 01922-07-02 (LOCATED AT 7407 CARLISLE STREET) FROM NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL (CN) TO GENERAL COMMERCIAL (CG) (STAFF):

Mr. Pouliot made a motion to approve and Mrs. Condom seconded it. Mr. Walker stated that he understands this property is located behind the white house on Carlisle Street. Mayor King explained that the builder is purchasing the vacant property on the corner and the property the white house sits on. This property is surrounded by General Commercial. He further explained that the builder will be tearing down the white house and strip mall to build a commercial strip center with parking. Mr. Walker voiced his concerns about the traffic in that area. The vote for approval was 4 to 1 with Mr. Walker voting in opposition.
