August 25, 2020

The Irmo Town Council held a special meeting on Tuesday, August 25, 2020 at the Municipal Building, 7300 Woodrow Street, Irmo, SC 29063. Council Members in attendance were Mayor Walker, Councilwoman Condom, Councilmen Busch, Sickinger, and Danielson. Others present were Mr. Robert Brown, Town Administrator; Mrs. Renee Caviness, Clerk/Treasurer and Mr. Jake Moore, Town Attorney.

Mayor Walker called the regular meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS


A. FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE 20-17 TO AMEND THE IRMO TOWN CODE, CHAPTER 11, RENTAL PROPERTY REGISTRATION AND REGULATIONS; SECTION 11-12 – STANDARDS FOR RESIDENTIAL RENTAL UNIT (STAFF):

Mr. Sickinger made a motion to approve and it was not seconded. The motion failed due to a lack of a second. Mayor Walker announced the 2020 Okra Strut was canceled and explained that the Town Attorney, along with Larry Slaughter, Okra Strut Chairman, will work with the band "Sister Hazel" to resolve any contractual issues.
