

TOWN OF IRMO REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

November 19, 2019

The Irmo Town Council held a regular meeting on Tuesday, November 19, 2019 in the Municipal Building. Council members present were Mayor King, Councilmen Pouliot, Walker, Waites and Councilwoman Condom. Others present were Mr. Robert Brown, Town Administrator; Chief Don Perry; Mrs. Renee Caviness, Clerk/Treasurer and Mr. Chip Burns, Town Attorney.

Mayor King called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and Mr. Pouliot led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave the Invocation.

READING OF THE MINUTES:

Mr. Pouliot made a motion to approve the October 15, 2019 minutes and Mr. Waites seconded the motion. The vote for approval was unanimous.

REPORT OF STANDING:

A. Administrative Briefing – Mr. Brown furnished a written briefing to Town Council in their packets and had nothing else to add.

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNICATIONS:

A. Mr. Todd Highsmith informed Council that the audit of the Town's financial statements as of June 30, 2019, had been completed and found them to be in compliance with Federal and State Statutes. He also reviewed a few of the financial statements and answered Council's questions.

B. Mr. Larry Slaughter stated that the festival was a great event where attendance was full for both Friday and Saturday night bands. They plan to use their reserves to purchase 100 traffic cones for the future Struts.

C. Mr. Walker had a meeting with the citizens at the Irmo Town Park to get feedback on the increase in sewer prices proposed by Blue Granite. He also stated that a request has been sent to Blue Granite and the PSC for a night meeting with Council and Irmo Residents

Mayor King made a motion to approve and Mr. Pouliot seconded it. Mayor King explained that the owners only want to rezone one acre of land from Planned Development District (PDD) to General Commercial (CG). Due to this change, the vote for approval failed unanimously.

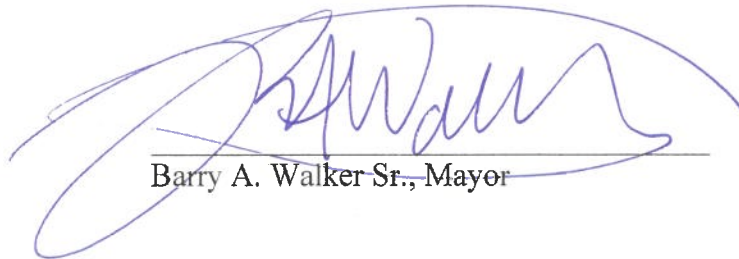
